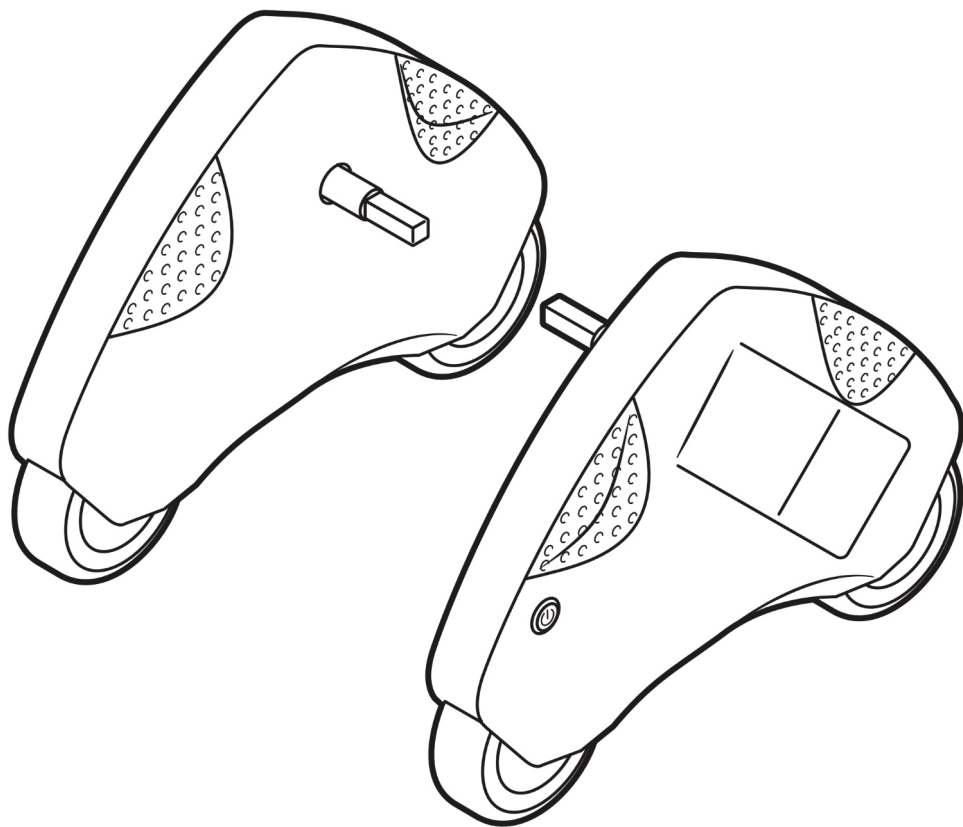

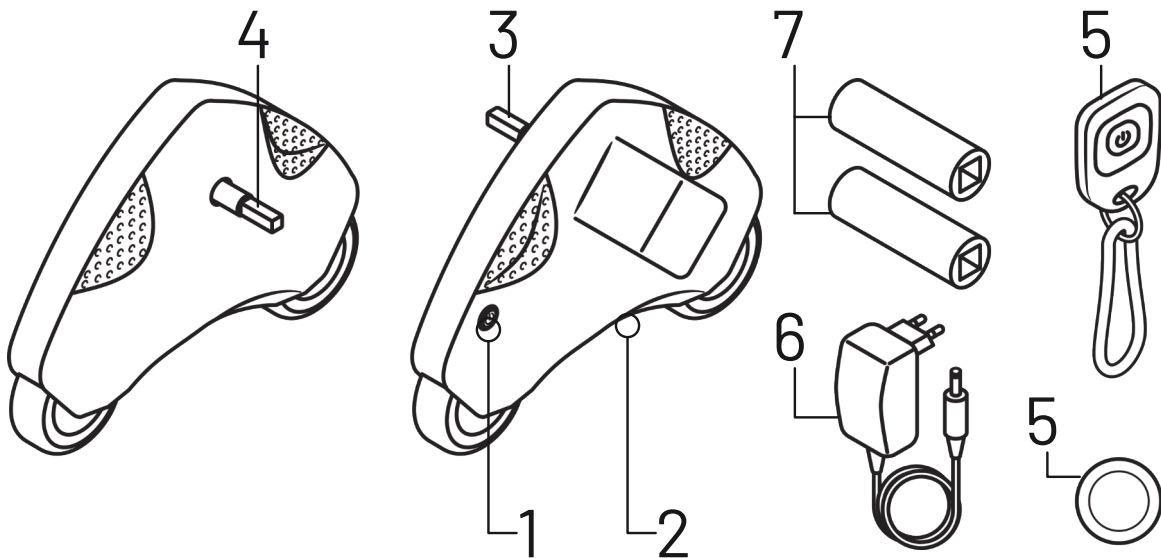
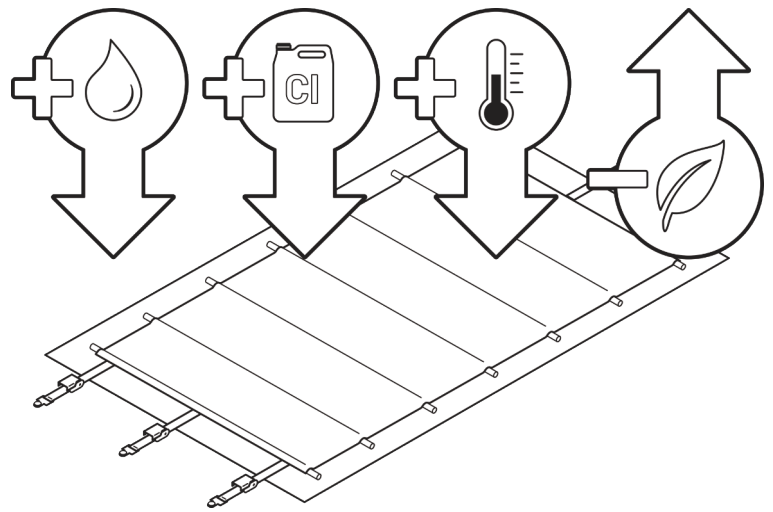

We created Padolo to quickly roll and unroll your bar pool cover.

Covering your pool when it is not in use helps reducing the evaporation of water and treatment chemicals, keeps out leaves and pollen, and retains heat..



1 : Padolo Master : On/Off switch.
2 : Female connector for charger.
3 : Padolo Master : Male axe, to be inserted into the first bar.

4 : Padolo Follower : Male axe, to be inserted into the first bar.
5 : Remote control.
6 : 220V-Charger.
7 : [Optional] Female/female adapter, for bar with male squares.

Light on continuously:



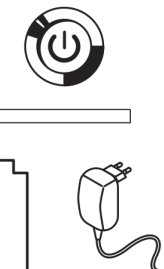

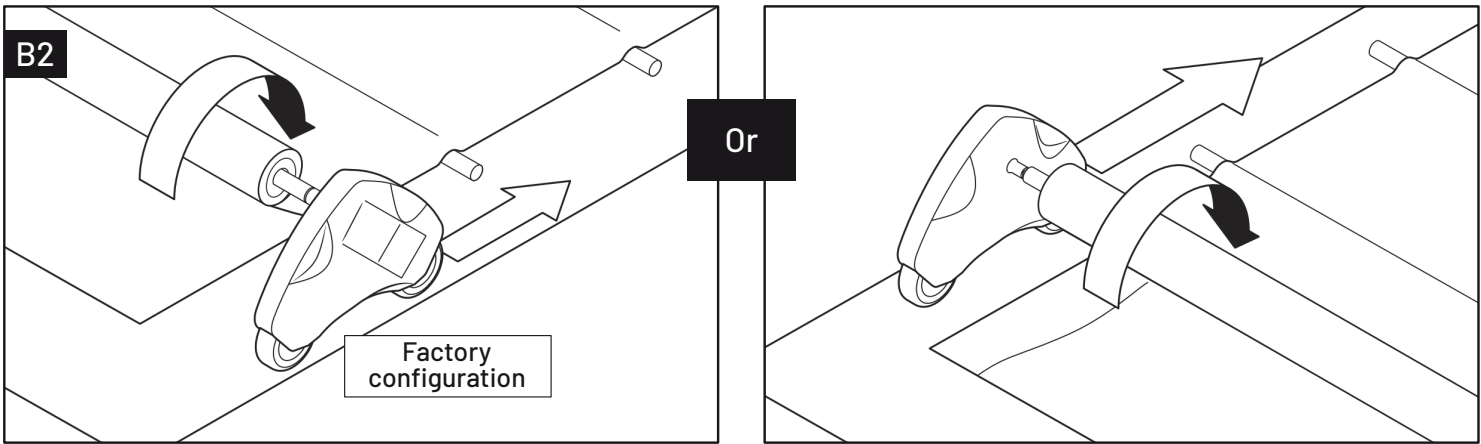
Note: Store the charger (6) in a dry place.

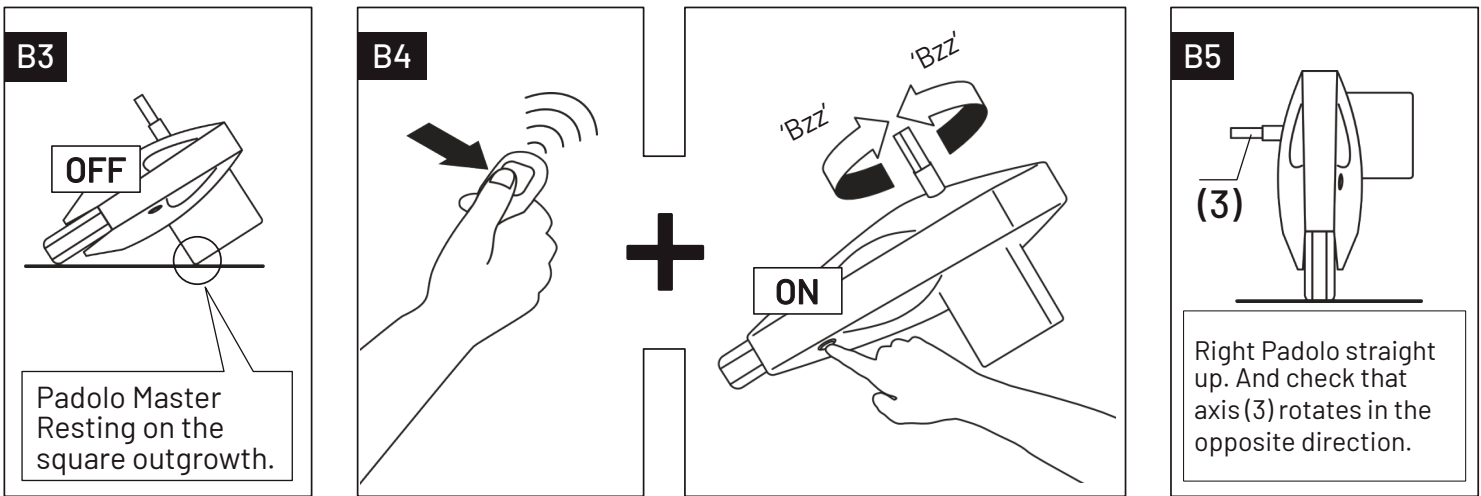

The cover must roll up by passing under the bar.

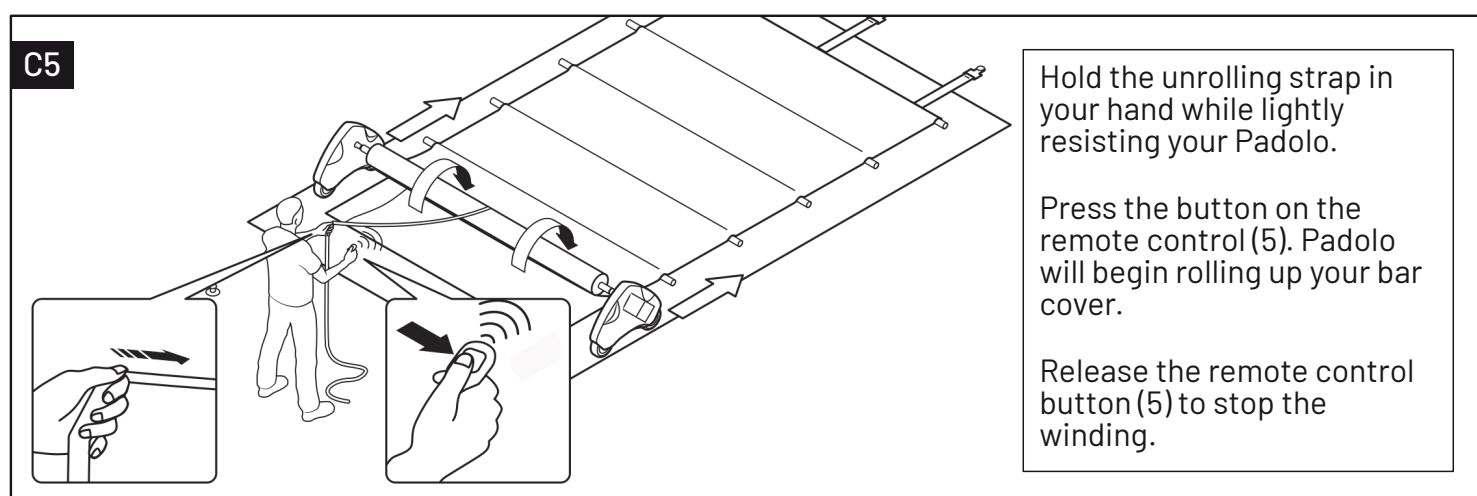
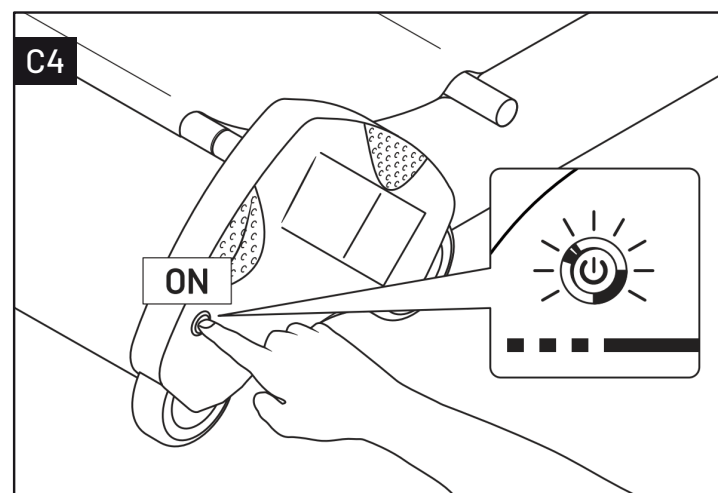
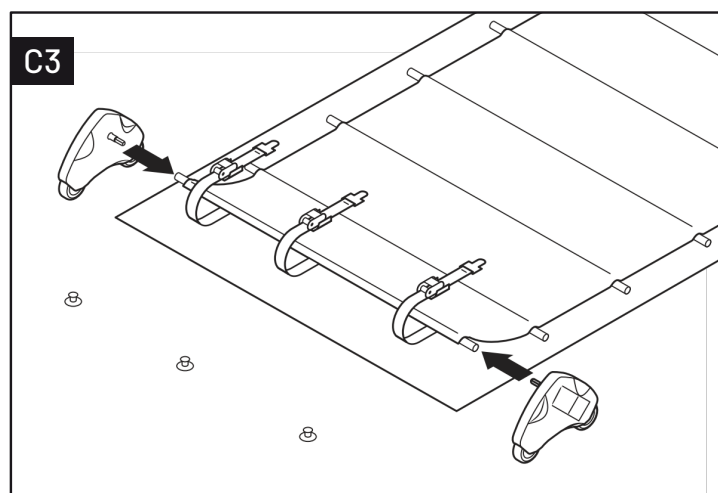
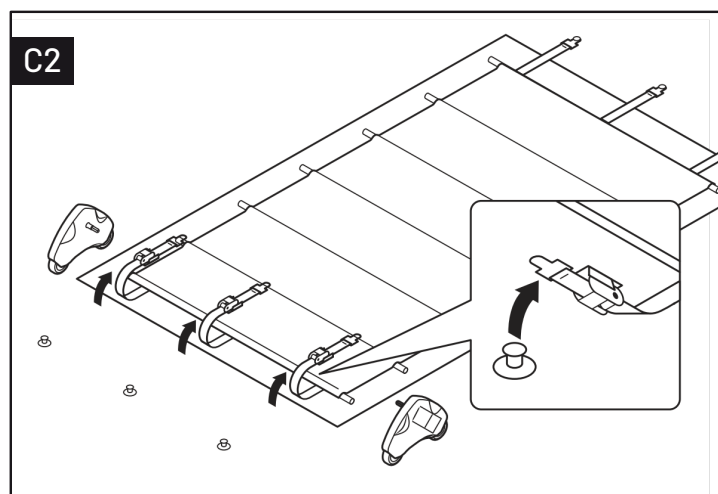
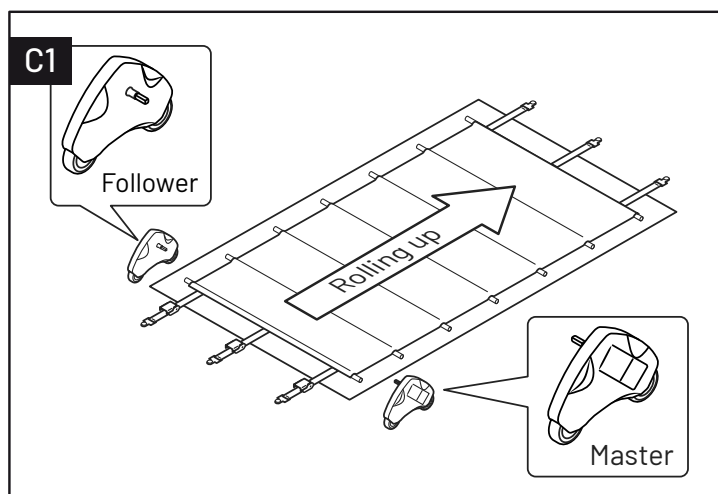


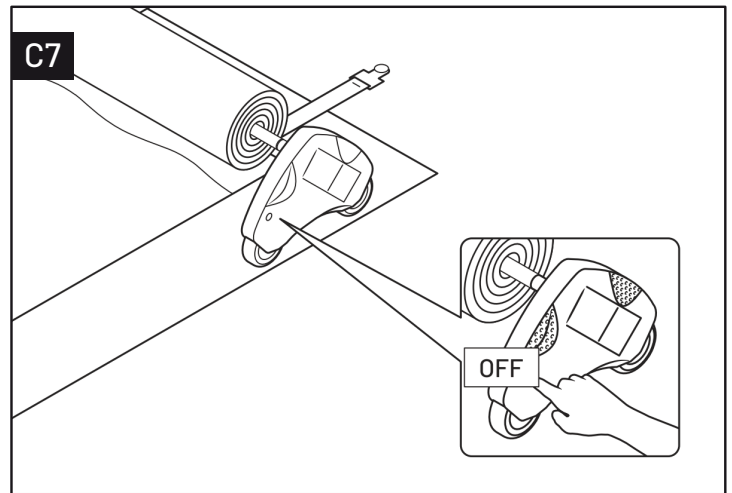
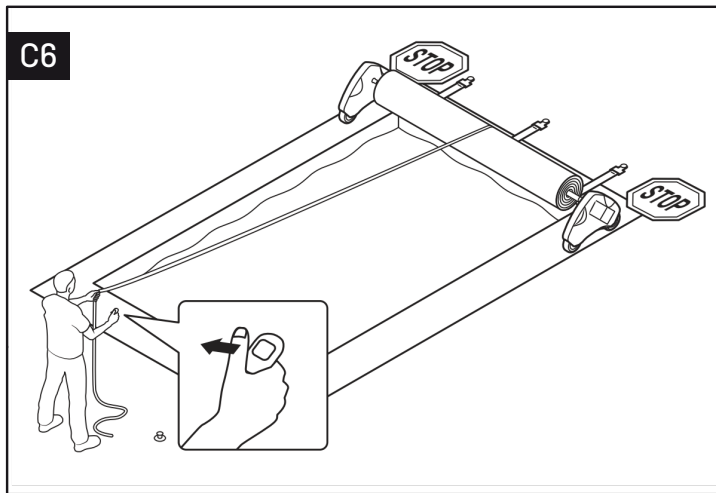
To change the winding direction of the Master module* :

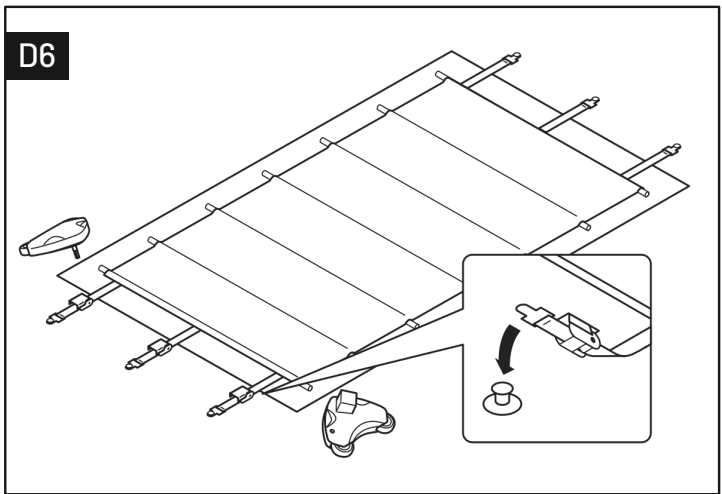
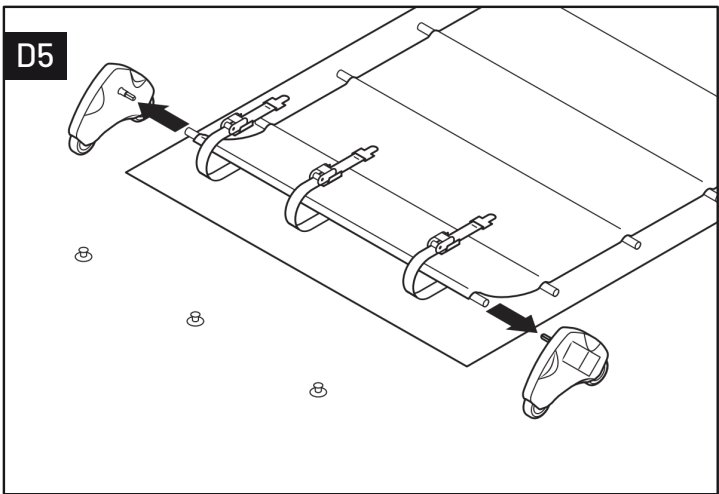
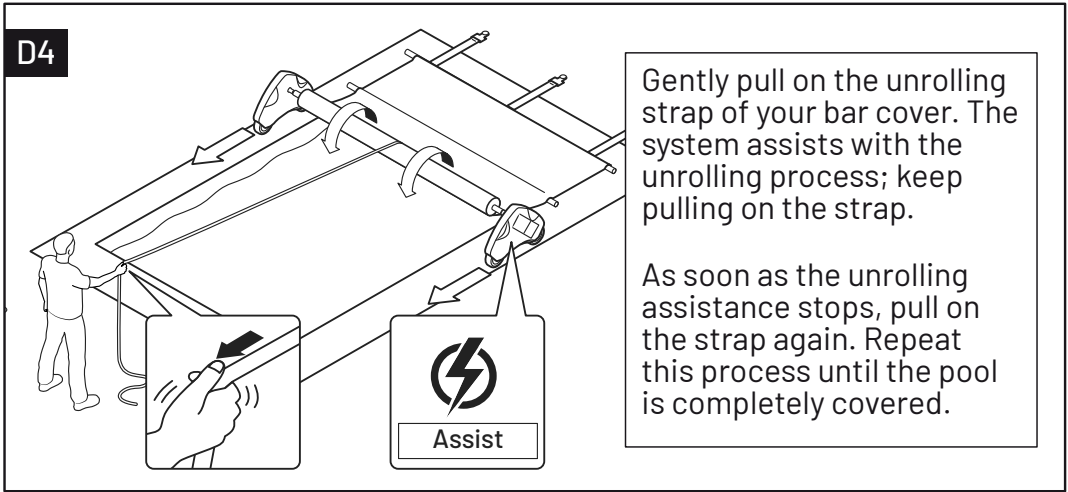
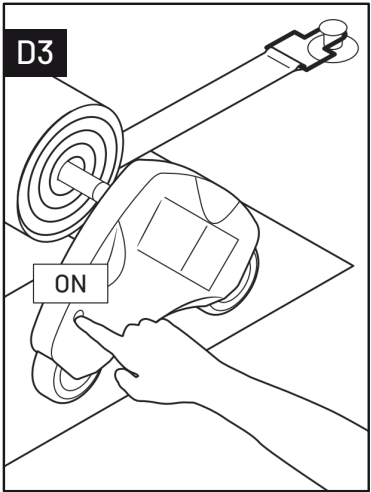
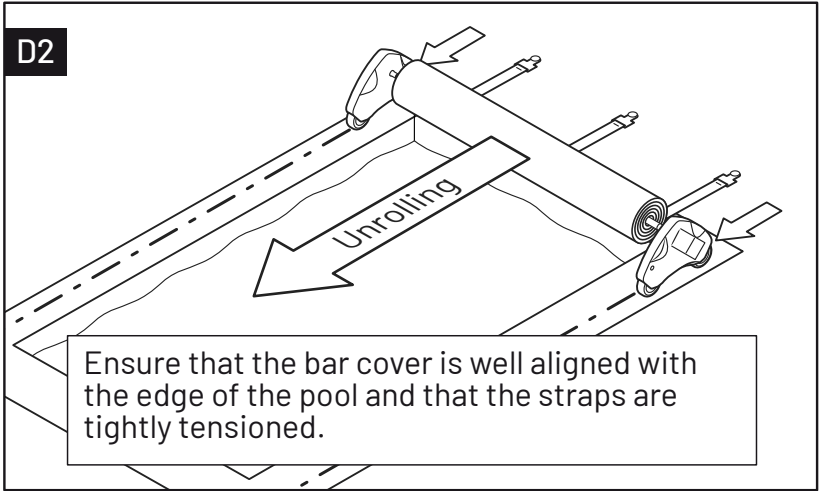
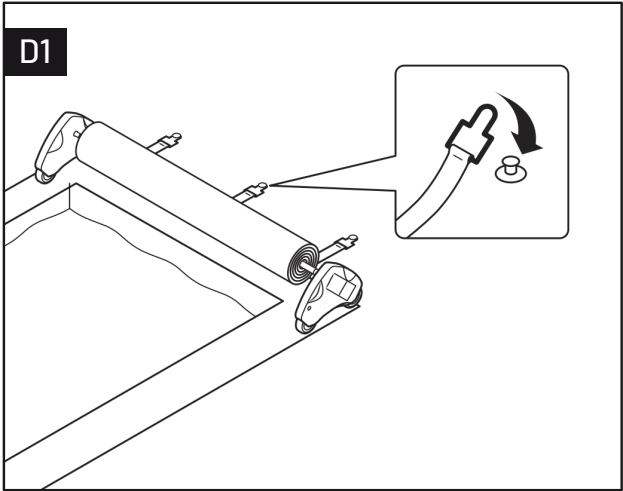


If the 4th pool side need to be cleared:

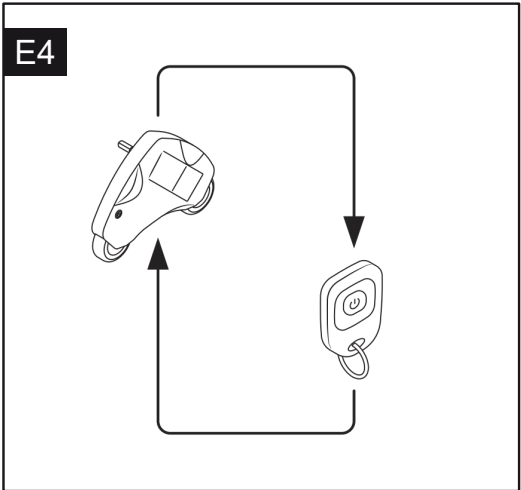
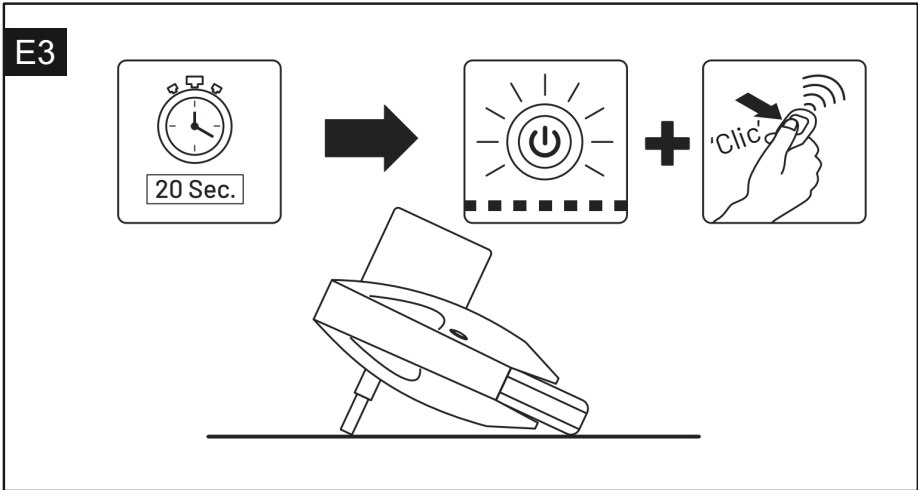
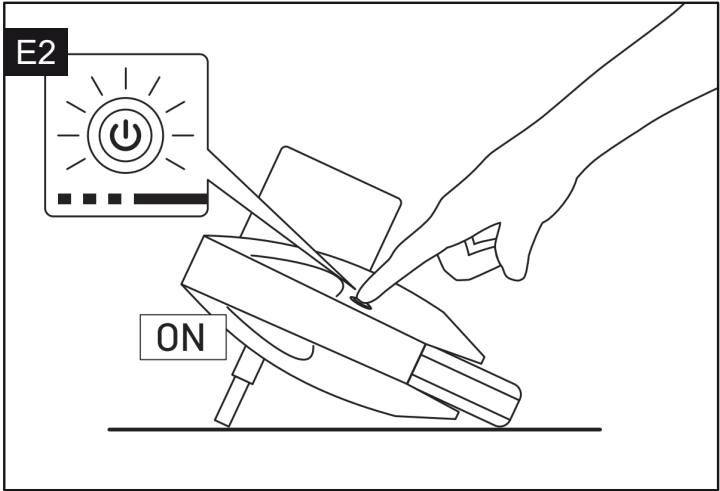
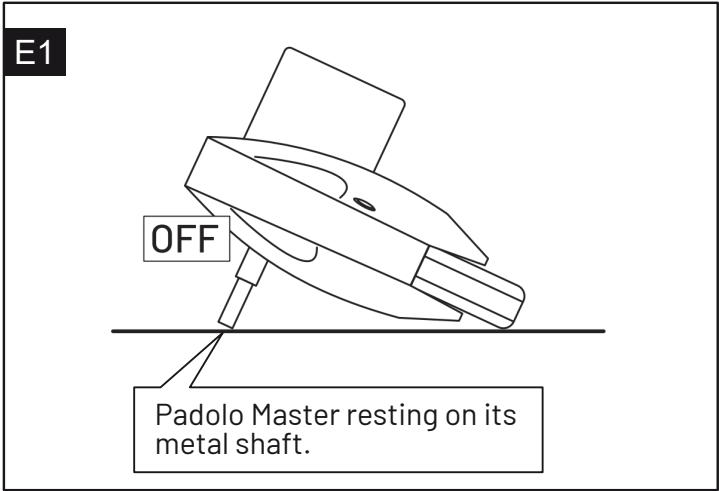
Padolo allows you to clear the fourth side and fully enjoy your pool.

E: Pairing a new remote control*



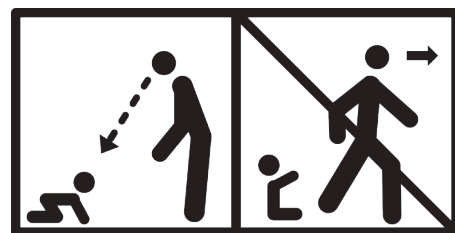
Note: If you missed the flashing button, you can wait another 20 seconds for it to flash again.

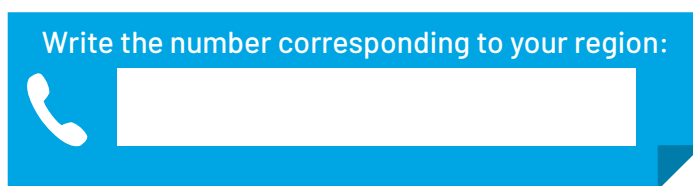
Safety Instructions

The pool can present a serious danger to your children. Drowning can happen very quickly, even if they know how to swim.

The physical presence of a responsible adult is essential when the pool is open.



Stay vigilant, learn life-saving techniques, and display these emergency numbers near the pool:



A child can drown in less than 3 minutes.

No pool cover system can replace common sense or individual responsibility. Nor is it intended to act as a substitute for the supervision and vigilance of parents and/or responsible adults, which remain the essential factors for protecting young children.

Safety is only guaranteed when the cover system is closed, locked, and correctly installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

A cover system must always be deployed whenever you are away from home, even momentarily.

Store your Padolo and any devices required to operate the covers out of reach of children. It is strictly forbidden to climb, walk, or jump on a safety cover system.

In the event of repairs to the cover system, a detected malfunction preventing the closing and securing of the pool, or temporary unavailability, take all necessary measures to prevent children from accessing the pool.

Always maintain the water levels specified by the manufacturer.

Never use your Padolo when a person or animal is in the pool. Ensure there are no swimmers or foreign objects in the pool before and during operation.

Safety Instructions (continued)

Never submerge your Padolo in water.

Never unhook your Padolo from the bar while it is operating.

Padolo is safety extra-low voltage (SELV) equipment. There is no risk of electric shock.

Padolo is a powerful piece of equipment. Only a responsible adult may operate it.

Children must not play with your Padolo.

Padolo can be used by children aged 15 and over, as well as by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or a lack of experience and knowledge, provided they are supervised or have been given instructions on how to use the device safely and understand the hazards involved.

In the event of a problem, do not open your Padolo; contact your retailer.

Ensure you read the user manual thoroughly before operating Padolo.

Miscellaneous

The remote control, charger, female/female adapter, or battery can be replaced. Contact your dealer.

Care, maintenance, and winterizing

Maintenance is the customer's responsibility.

Store your Padolo and its charger in a dry place, away from children and chlorine-based products.

During the season, recharge your Padolo at least every 4 months.

For winter storage, store the recharged Padolo in a temperate place ($>16^{\circ}\text{C}$).

Recharge every 3 months if stored in a cold location (below 10°C).

Recycling

The packaging, instructions and eco-friendly memo can be recycled according to the current rules and regulations.

End-of-Life of Equipment

Do not discard scrapped material or used batteries with unsorted household waste.

It is your responsibility to dispose of all your waste, particularly electrical and electronic equipment, by taking it to a designated collection point for recycling and recovery.

Some products potentially contain substances hazardous to the environment; these will be eliminated or neutralized.
